PREPARE TO STAY!



Know your rights first!

- 1. You have the right to **remain silent.**
- 2. You have the right to speak with a lawyer.

3. If law enforcement shows up to your house, DO NOT OPEN

THE DOOR. Ask them to slide the warrant under the door.

It has to be signed by a judge, and have your name or address.

- 4. Never carry false documentation with you (It's a crime)
- 5.If detained, only say your name and DOB.

Prepare a Family Plan!

- Know what documents you should carry with you
 - 1. Know Your Rights Čard
 - 2. Immigration attorney's phone number
 - 3. Any valid Identification from the US
- Make a plan to care for your family

1. Consult with an immigration attorney about your situation and your family's

2. Have the attorney's phone number at a visible place (on your refrigerator) and let your family know

3. Prepare a Caregiver Affidavit where someone trusted, agrees to care for your children, in case you are arrested

• Keep a copy of all important documents in a safe and easy to access location 1. Birth and marriage Certificate, passports, and alien number (A#) if have one

• Start Saving money for your defense (\$\$\$\$\$)

1. Immigration procedures are expensive, including immigration bond and legal Representation.

Remember, you have **Rights** under the Constitution, regardless of your immigration status.
